Parshas Vayigash Questions

1. What is the name of this week's parsha? (Vayigash)
2. What was found in Binyomin's bags last parsha? (Yosef's cup)
3. What did Yosef say he was going to do about it? (keep Binyomin as a slave)
4. What did Yehuda say about that? (He begged Yosef to keep him instead and said his father would be so upset since he already lost Yosef).
6. When Yosef heard this, what did he tell everyone else in the room? (he told them to leave)
7. Once Yosef was alone with his brothers, what did he tell them? (That he was their brother Yosef!)
8. When the brothers went back to get Yaakov, who told Yaakov the news about Yosef being alive? (Serach)
9. How did she tell him? (she sang and played music)
10. How did Yaakov feel? (very happy)
11. When Yaakov finally saw Yosef what did they do? (hug)
12. What land did Yosef give to his family to live? (Goshen)
13. What did the brothers make sure they had in their new land? (a Yeshiva to learn Torah)
